Canada Student Services Grant: June – October 2020 (start and end dates flexible)

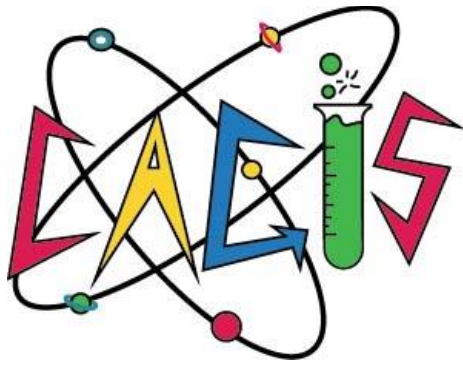
Earn \$1000 per 100 hours volunteered via the Canada Student Services Grant

Location: This is a work-from-home position

Organization Description: The Canadian Association for Girls In Science (CAGIS) is an award-winning club for girls aged 7 to 16 that supports interest in Science, Technology, Trades, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). CAGIS chapter members meet monthly to explore STEM with fun, hands-on activities led by women and men who are experts in a variety of STEM fields. These monthly events often occur at the work places of our STEM experts, giving girls a behind-the-scenes view and allowing them to experience the lab and field environment for themselves.

Position Summary: This position will involve web design for kids and teens:

- creating drafts of kid-friendly and teen-friendly website designs;
- brainstorming fun and engaging online ideas for kids and teens;
- incorporating feedback from CAGIS participants (kids and teens), staff, and volunteers;
- refining the designs and working on the development of the website in partnership with staff, volunteers, and participants;
- performing other emerging web-related duties as identified.

- Ability to work independently and in a team environment with volunteers, staff, and partners;

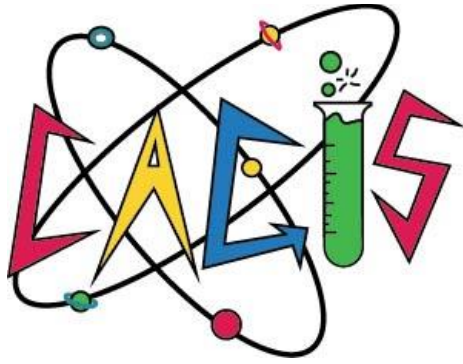
