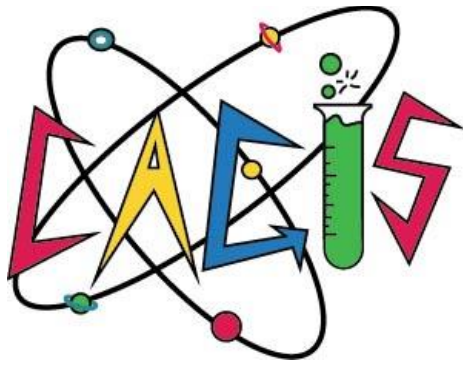
Canada Student Services Grant: June – October 2020 (start and end dates flexible)

CAGIS chapter members meet monthly to explore STEM with fun, hands-on activities led by women and men who are experts in a variety of STEM fields. These monthly events often occur at the work places of our STEM experts, giving girls a behind-the-scenes view and allowing them to experience the lab and field environment for themselves.

- Ability to work independently and in a team environment with volunteers, staff, and partners;

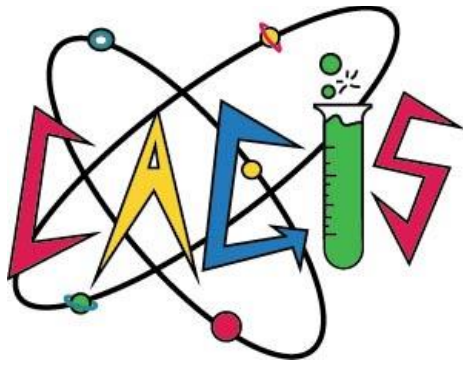
